Study

- Read the sections on Guitars, Keyboards, and Drums & Percussion sections of the ProGear guide three times:
 1. The first time, read through to become familiar with what's there
 2. The second time, write down questions in your assigned Google sheet
 3. The third time, pay attention to the style, and find Guitar, Keyboard, or Drum & Percussion product that you or a contact think is interesting but isn't in the catalog and learn enough about it to write your own blurb suitable for the catalog.
- Look through the words starting with the letters "A" through "M" in the [Sweetwater Glossary](#) and make flash cards for yourself of terms that you don't know and you think might be important
