Abstract

The affordability of video cameras, digital audio recording systems, and desktop editing systems offer new resources for the production of rich multimedia content. The process of producing projects documenting regional and classical music events is described.

Theory students apply understanding gained from analysis to a new problem: translating scores into instructions for camera operators and editors. Media students implement these plans with multi-channel audio and multi-angle video recordings, which are then mixed and edited during postproduction, using Pro Tools, Final Cut Pro, Photoshop, and DVD Studio Pro software. Interaction between theory and media students fosters collaboration and new contacts, and the teamwork and wide range of skills brought to bear result in recordings that are more satisfying to performers, going beyond simple feedback tools to become artistic works in themselves. The results are distributed on DVDs integrated with websites.

A methodology for directing video recordings is presented, incorporating comments on philosophy, technique and style obtained from interviews with professional directors.
